Located in Southwest Minneapolis, the goal of Lynnhurst's Summer Art Program is to provide a summer of art activities for all children and young people in a safe, creative and fun social and educational environment.

We welcome kids from throughout the community, regardless of their faith, religion, race or gender. At the end of the program, friends and family will be invited to see the final products and celebrate art!

### Summer Arts Program for 2009

---

This summer the class offering will be the **Clockhead Clock Club**. We are planning to expand our arts program and add even more interesting classes next year with additional Artist/Teachers.

## Do you know what time it is?

**It's time to make some art at the Clockhead Clock Club!**



**Instructor:** Henry Taly

**Skill Level:** All

In this class, students will create an original personal clock that actually works, while learning the basics of art.

Students will go from imagination to drawing and planning a design, to construction and creating a surface texture using a thick acrylic emulsion with special tools. They will then paint their clock, exploring different ways of painting besides using a brush.

Finally, the students will participate in the assembly of a working clock, sign and date it and have a photo taken with their clock. Each student will also receive a **Clockhead Clock Club** certificate from the Head Clockhead, Henry Taly.

## Instructor Information

---



The Clockhead Clock Club class will be taught by Henry Taly. Henry has a BFA in Design and Studio Arts, University of Wisconsin. He has been a working artist and designer most of his life, creating designs for homes and industries. Trained in studio arts of drawing, painting and photography, Henry continues to show in group and solo exhibits.

Over the past several years, Henry has taught artistic expression to children, developing programs such as the “**Clockhead Clock Club**”, in which kids design and ultimately produce a working clock and the “**Tile Wall Project**”, which introduces children to the basic elements of art, individual creativity and collaboration. An important element of these programs and other activities he has taught is learning to see the beauty and opportunity in unexpected objects, re-using and re-inventing material to create art.

### Artist Henry Taly says:

“I started the Clockhead Clock Club to help give creative nurturing to kids. I felt the need because ever since I was in kindergarten, I was lucky enough to receive special guidance from teachers to allow my talent to develop. I want to share the joy of creativity with children of all ages, as an honorary uncle and art guy.”

- AA Battery
- Acrylic emulsion for texturing
- Texturing Tools
- Sketch paper
- Cardboard blanks for texture and paint designs

Student provides oversized T-shirt to protect their clothing.

### Program Objective

---

To create an imaginative personal clock that actually works, while learning the basics of art.

#### Activity Plan:

- Day One:** Learn about creativity and design/drawing exercises and create clock design.
- Day Two:** Applying acrylic emulsion for surface texture.
- Day Three:** Creating the clock shape and experimenting with painting.
- Day Four:** Completing color experimentation and designs.
- Day Five:** Assembling clocks.

#### Safety Info:

The instructor will cut clock shapes at his studio between classes. Students will sand and finish clocks by hand.
